During the 1st European Soil Partnership Meeting that was held in Ispra (Italy) in May 2014, emphasis was placed on the withdrawal of the proposal for a Soil Framework Directive (see Regulatory Fitness and Performance (REFIT) - COM(2013) 685 final). The European Commission noted that the proposal had been pending for eight years, during which time no effective action had resulted. So, the Commission in May 2014 decided to withdraw the proposal for a Soil Framework Directive.

Nevertheless, the Seventh Environment Action Programme, which entered into force on January 2014, recognises that soil degradation is a serious challenge. It provides that by 2020 land would be managed sustainably in the European Union, soil adequately protected and the remediation of contaminated sites well underway, and commits the EU and its Member States to an increasing effort to reduce soil erosion, increase soil organic matter content, and to remediate contaminated sites.

We believe that this is not enough and that such commitment must be followed by <u>effective</u> <u>and positive actions</u> to preserve the multi-functionality of soil and its vital role in the environmental equilibrium and human health and welfare.
